1. PREAMBLE:

WHEREAS it is expedient to establish a National Organisation having exclusive rights:

- 1.1 To administer, govern, organise, control and promote the game of Hockey; and
- 1.2 To provide a general code for the conduct of Provincial Hockey Associations, autonomous bodies, service organisations, institutions, Government Departments, Banks, etc. associated with the game of Hockey in Pakistan;

2. NAME:

The Organisation shall be called PAKISTAN HOCKEY FEDERATION.

3. JURISDICTION:

The Jurisdiction of Pakistan Hockey Federation shall extend throughout Pakistan including A.J. & K, Gilgit & Baltistan and FATA

4. COMMENCEMENT:

The Constitution of Pakistan Hockey Federation comes into force at once on the approval of the Congress and notification/directive issued by the President of Pakistan Hockey Federation.

5. SECRETARIAT:

It shall be located in the city of Lahore.

6. ¹[AUTONOMY:

- 6.1 The Pakistan Hockey Federation, a National Association, shall be an autonomous body that, in accordance with the terms and conditions of registration with the International Olympic Committee (IOC) through the Pakistan Olympic Association (POA) and the terms and conditions of its membership with the International Federation of Hockey (FIH), shall:
- a. Preserve the independence of the PHF in all matters directly or indirectly concerning Hockey in Pakistan without the intervention of any outside authority; and
- b. Make no provisions or rules that are contrary to the IOC Charter or the FIH Statute & Rules;
- whilst abiding by the terms and conditions of its membership with the FIH and IOC, accept assistance, grants and aid from, and cooperate with, the Pakistan Sports Board.
- 6.2 If there is any doubt as to the implication or the interpretation of the provisions of the Constitution of the PHF or if there is any provision or rule of the PHF that is contrary to the IOC Charter or the FIH Statute & Rules, the IOC Charter and FIH Statute & Rules shall take precedence.

6.3 The PHF shall not violate the International Olympic Movement principle of ensuring that there shall be no discrimination on grounds of sex, politics, race, religion or creed.

7. AFFILIATION:

The Pakistan Hockey Federation shall be affiliated with the Federation of International Hockey, the Asian Hockey Federation, Pakistan Sports Board and the Pakistan Olympic Association.

9. OBJECTS:

9.4

9.1 To promote, control, develop and organise the game of hockey at all levels in Pakistan and to protect and safeguard the interests of all its members. The objects of the PHF shall include:

9.2 To make Rules, Regulations, By-laws and issue

Directives on all matters related, thereto;

9.3 To conduct itself and to take such administrative, financial and other measures are necessary, in conformity with and in furtherance to its objects;

To preserve its independence in all matters, directly and indirectly, concerning the game of hockey, from intervention of any extraneous agency against its will

and in its relations with the affiliated units:

9.5 To raise and utilize funds for the promotion of the game including purchase, lease, sale, hire or exchange of

moveable or immovable properties;

9.6 To affiliate, subscribe and associate with National or International Associations/ Federations having similar objects, as long as their Statutes and By-laws are compatible with that of the AHF/FIH; and

9.7 To take all such measures which the PHF deems expedient for the attainment of its objects.

10. MEMBERSHIP:

All affiliated units shall be the members of PHF and their representatives having the right to vote in the Congress.

10.1 All affiliated member may be relegated to the position of "adherent member" by the Board for non-compliance of conditions laid down in the Constitution and disregard of by-laws/directives of PHF.

10.2 NFW MFMBFRSHIP:

New member (s) may be admitted to PHF by the Congress on the recommendations of the Board, subject to fulfillment of conditions prescribed by PHF. 10.3 Adherent member (s) may be admitted on the recommendations of the Board, subject to fulfillment of conditions prescribed by the Congress. 10.4 SUSPENSION OF MEMBERSHIP: The membership of any unit be suspended on nonfulfillment of conditions, prescribed from time to time by the Board. POWER TO SUSPEND: 10.5 Upon advice of Secretary General, the President may suspend any unit (s)/functionary (s)/ office-bearer (s)/player (s) on serious charges of irregularities, malpractices, violation of Constitution, disregard of by-laws/directives or any other charge of blemishing the name of PHF/Pakistan. 10.6 WITHDRAWAL OF SUSPENSION: The suspension of the unit (s)/ functionary (s)/officebearer (s)/ player (s) may be withdrawn by President or the Board upon exoneration after due inquiry/ appeal. SUBSCRIPTON FOR MEMBERSHIP: 10.7 The financial year of PHF shall be from 1st July to 30th June: 10.7.1 The annual subscription of the affiliated members as determined by the Board in By-laws, shall be payable before the 30th of June; 10.7.2 The adherent members shall pay annual subscription to the PHF as determined by the Board in the By-laws; 10.7.3 Upon admission, a new adherent member shall pay Registration Fee to the PHF as determined by the Board, which shall not be refundable. LEGISLATIVE, EXECUTIVE & ADMINISTRATIVE BODIES 11.1 The Congress shall be the legislative body of PHF with respect to amendments in the Constitution or making a new Constitution; 11.2 The Board shall be the executive body of PHF with powers to enact By-laws; 11.3 The Secretariat shall be the administrative body of PHF; 11.4 The Sub-Committee (s) will serve to assist in the proper administration of PHF, by making

12. CONGRESS:

12.1 COMPOSITION:

The Congress shall consist of the President and the representatives of the members ⁵[the following basis:-

12.2 One representative from each of the eligible District Hockey Association (s) elected by the DHA, duly affiliated with its respective Provincial Hockey Association.

- 12.3 A District Hockey Association having five or more approved and affiliated clubs within the administrative boundary of the District shall have the right to vote and contest any office/membership of the PHF.
- 12.4 One representative each of Islamabad Hockey Association/FATA/AJK/Gilgit & Biltistan.
- One representative each of the organisations, including autonomous bodies and Banks, affiliated with the PHF.

MEETINGS:

Congress shall meet once every year before 31st December. Extra-ordinary meetings may be held under the following circumstances:

- 12.10.1 When requested by decision of Board;
- 12.10.2 Within 14 days of the receipt of a requisition signed by $1/3^{rd}$ of the strength of the Congress;
- 12.10.3 Under orders of the President.
- 12.11 QUORUM:

One-third of total members of the Congress shall form a quorum for the meeting of the Congress and for a requisition meeting the quorum will be two-third.

If the quorum is not complete, meeting shall be adjourned for the following day, then irrespective of quorum.

13. ¹¹[EXECUTIVE BOARD:

There shall be an Executive Board, which shall be elected by the Congress for a term of four years. The Board shall comprise the following]:-

13.6.9	To deal with any or all matters connected or ancillary thereto in connection with any of the above powers, duties and functions for the attainment of the objects of PHF.
13.7	FILLING OF VACANCY: Any vacancy caused in the Board due to death, resignation, vote of no-confidence or invalidity of any office-bearer/representative shall be filled-in by the Board for the remainder of the term, except
EICCAL.	in the case of the President.

14. FISCAL:

The HF may allocate grant-in-aid to Provincial Hockey Associations, commensurate with the activities of the respective Association.

15. PATRON-IN-CHIEF:

The Prime Minister of Pakistan will be the Patron-in-Chief of PHF. The Patron-in-Chief, if attending the extra-ordinary meeting of the Board/Congress shall preside over the meeting. ¹⁴[The Patron-in-Chief will nominate the President in the event of a vacancy].

16. PATRON:

The Patron (s) may be appointed by the Board, who in its opinion shall be of optimal patronage, support and guidance for the promotion of the game of hockey in Pakistan. The Patron (s) may be invited to attend the extra-ordinary sessions of the Congress and Board.

PROVINCIAL HOCKEY ASSOCIATION: 24.1

There shall be Provincial Hockey Association in the

boundaries of a Province, affiliated with the PHF and constituted under its own Constitution duly approved by PHF;

Provided that the General Body of the Provincial Hockey Association shall be constituted by one representative each of the respective District Hockey Association in that Province;

²⁸[Provided further that DHA of Lahore will have three, Karachi four, Faisalabad two and Peshawar two representatives in the Provincial Hockey Association];

Islamabad being Federal territory shall have its own Hockey Association constituted by the approved/ scrutinized clubs of the territory within the administrative boundary of the Federal Capital. Similarly, FATA/ AJK/Gilgit & Biltistan.

24.3 DISTRICT HOCKEY ASSOCIATION:

There shall be a District Hockey Association within the administrative boundaries of the District and affiliated with the Provincial Hockey Association, constituted under its own Constitution, duly affiliated with respective Provincial Hockey Association.

24.4 CLUB:

24.2

The basic unit of a District shall be Club, duly constituted, registered and affiliated with the District Hockey Association fulfilling the following conditions:-

24.4.1 Having at least 14 bona-fide amateur players;

24.4.2 ²⁹[Participating in the inter-club competition];

24.4.3 Certificate of sound financial position of the Club;

24.4.4 Copy of the Constitution of the Club;

24.4.5 LIST OF OFFICE-BEARERS:

Provided that no individual shall hold office of more than one club ³⁰[at a time]. If so, he/she shall not be eligible to vote on behalf of more than one of the Clubs in which holding office;

Provided further that District shall be the basic unit for the PHF Women's Council/Provincial Women's Hockey Association and that the aforementioned provision of the Constitution shall not be applicable to them.

24.5 TRANSFER OF PLAYERS:

24.5.1 The transfer period of player (s) from one Club to another, shall be first fortnight of January and July each year. Department/Service player (s) may seek transfer from parent Club/ District within one month of their joining service;

Provided the players employed in Department/ Stipend Holders. Contract Basis shall fulfill all the requirements. For ³¹[their transference from one Department to another] they must produce 'relieving certificate' and the 'joining report' of the new Department.

25. FLOATING OF PARALLEL ASSOCIATIONS:

25.1 Floating of parallel Associations at any level shall be ³²[prohibited]. Only one Association duly constituted under its Constitution in a Province/District recognized by PHF, shall be the bona-fide unit.

25.2 Any person (s), inciting/ instrumental or participating in formation of parallel body shall be declared person-non-grata and debarred for life from any activities of PHF.

26. DISCIPLINE: 26.1

Litigation among members or Provincial Associations and District Associations shall be prohibited. For any dispute or controversy; the matter shall be resolved in accordance with the arbitration proceedings as laid down in the POA Charter.

Provided in case of any individual/official /club having grievances or dispute shall first approach respective District Hockey Association, failing settlement, appeal to the respective Provincial Hockey Association and if still aggrieved, shall have the right to appeal to President whose decision in the matter, after giving proper hearing, shall be final and binding.

26.2 Strict measures amounting to suspension /expulsion/debarment may be taken by

³³[President/Board against such person/ Association who violates the foregoing and resorts] to litigation. 26.3 Member (s) may take disciplinary action against their unit (s)/official (s)/player (s) /functionary (s) and upon receipt of intimation, the ³⁴[Secretary General] shall Notify such action to all units. 26.4 Where a District Hockey Association fails to participate in the Preliminary Rounds of two consecutive National Hockey Championships, the office-bearers shall be suspended. Provided the suspension will be withdrawn on recommendations of Provincial Hockey Association concerned, upon taking remedial measures to improve, under Article 10.6. Provided further that if the suspension is not withdrawn, in the manner above said, fresh elections shall be held of the District Hockey Association. 35 NO-CONFIDENCE: One third (1/3) members of Congress will give in 27.1 writing "No-confidence Motion" against particular office-bearer of PHF giving reasons; 27.2 Immediately on receipt of the Motion, consultation with President, the Secretary General shall issue Notice for holding an extra-ordinary meeting of the Congress at a date, time and venue, within 10 days of the receipt of Notice; 27.3 The Congress meeting will be presided by the President. The quorum for which shall be 50%; 27.4 In the meeting, the official concerned will be given opportunity to explain the charges, if he so desired. abstaining to attend the meeting, proceedings will be conducted ex parte and decision taken with a 2/3 majority of the members present and voting and the official proceeded against, shall stand removed from office, forthwith; 27.5 If the Motion is not carried then those of the members filing the Motion will be debarred and their seats in the PHF setup, shall stand

immediately vacated.

28. AMENDMENT:

28.1 If the ³⁶[Board] approves the proposal with 2/3 majority, the proposal along with

recommendations shall be placed on the Agenda of

the Congress;

28.2 Such proposal, if approved by 2/3rd majority of the

Congress, shall be deemed to have been

Provided no proposal for amendment in the Constitution can be made in Congress unless it has

previously been approved by the Board;

28.3 The Congress may annul/abrogate the Constitution

of PHF with 3/4th majority.

29. ³⁷[REMOVAL OF DIFFICULTY]:

29.1 For expediency/or any difference of opinion, with

regard to the provisions of this Constitution, or any By-laws of PHF, the matter shall be referred to the Congress or in case of emergency, to the President/ Secretary General, whose decision shall be final

and binding on all and shall not be appealable.
