Pakistan Badminton team participated in the Dubai Junior International Series Badminton Tournament played in Dubai from 26-30 September, 2018 in which Raza Ali Adil reached in the semi final of U-19 and won Bronze medal.

Pakistan Baseball team participated in BFA U-12 Asian Baseball Championship- 2018 held in China from 13th to 19th August, 2018 in which total 08 teams participated from different countries. Overall performance of Pakistan U-12 Team was good. Pakistan got 4th position in the event.

Hamza Khan won Gold Medal in U-15, Haris Qasim won Gold Medal in U-17 and Abbas Zeb won Gold Medal in U-19 categories while Ashab Irfan and Uzair Shaukat lost in quarter finals of U-15 & U-17 age.

Pakistan Junior Squash team comprising of Abbas Zeb, Farhan Hashmi, Haris, Qasim and Hamza Khan participated in Asian Junior Team Squash Championship held at Pattaya (Thailand) from 16-20 January, 2019. Pakistan team given an excellent performance and won Gold Medal in the prestigious Championship after 6 years.
