**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN
AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF HIS MAJESTY THE SULTAN AND
YANG DI-PERTUAN OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM
ON
COOPERATION IN THE FIELDS OF CULTURE AND RELATED ACTIVITIES**

The Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and the Government of His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam hereinafter jointly referred to as "the Participants"

DESIRING to further develop and strengthen the firm relationships understanding and cooperation in the spheres of culture, arts, youth, sports and welfare between the two countries

RECOGNISING the importance of bilateral relations in the fields of cultural exchanges between the two countries

GUIDED by the mutual respect for the principles of equality and mutual benefits

Have reached the following understanding:

- 1. The Participants will endeavour to encourage cooperation and make recommendation in the fields of arts, culture, youth, sports and welfare in order to contribute towards a better understanding of their respective cultures and activities
- 2. The Participants will encourage the mutual participation in the cultural exchanges in order to stimulate cooperation and strengthen the bilateral relations in the fields of arts, culture, youth, sports and welfare of the two countries
- 3. The Participants on a reciprocal basis will encourage, support and facilitate the following activities:
 - 3.1. Exchange of respective experts and the training of personnel to promote technical assistance in the field of culture and related activities
 - 3.2. Exchange of visits of respective officials by both countries and their participations in any forums in the fields of culture and related activities
 - 3.3. Exchange of information and materials in the fields of arts, culture, youth, sports and welfare of the two countries
 - 3.4. Exchange of experts in the fields of Archaeology for a period of 15 days to acquaint the culture of each other's country

- 3.5- Exchange of photographic exhibition for a period of 3 months to depict the rich cultural heritage of the two countries.
- 3.6- Exchange of publication in the field of archaeology and its allied subjects.
4. Each Participant will be responsible for the costs of its participation in activities including accommodation and international travel and in the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding. Expenses incurred as a result of any cooperative activities will be shared in a manner to be jointly decided upon by the Participants.
5. This Memorandum of Understanding will enter into effect on the date of its signature and will continue in effect until terminated by either of the two Participants giving six months written notice through diplomatic channels. Such termination will not affect on going projects or activities unless decided otherwise by the Participants.
6. Any alterations or amendments to this Memorandum of Understanding will be mutually agreed upon by the Participants through an Exchange of Letter and will come into effect from the date of its signing.
7. In the event of any dispute or disagreement in the interpretation or application of this Memorandum of Understanding the Participants will resolve the matter amicably by consultations or negotiations in the spirit of cordiality and mutual respect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Memorandum of Understanding.
