Cooperation in the Field of Sports and Youth
Between Islamic Republic of Pakistan and Republic of Yemen

In keeping with importance of the cooperation between the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and the Republic of Yemen, realizing the need to deepen this cooperation in a manner that serves the interests of the two countries and with a view to strengthen these bonds and relations, this Protocol in the field of sports and youth is being signed.

First: General Framework

1. Coordination between the two Parties, for the benefits of the two countries, through the sports and youth meetings, conferences and forums on bilateral, continental and international levels.
2. Exchange of documents, information and films in the fields of sports and youth.
3. Learning about the experiments and expertise of the two countries in the fields of sports and youth.

Second: Field of Sports

1. Pakistan Sports Trust in collaboration with Pakistan Sports Board is already conducting coaching courses in various games, where the coaches from Yemen may attend the offered courses, the details of which will be decided through mutual understanding. Pakistan Sports Board will arrange their boarding and lodging at its sports hostels. The return airfare will be arranged by Yemeni side.
2. The exchange of football, taekwondo, table tennis teams and youth between the Parties will be encouraged.

Third: Field of Youth

1. Exchange of exploratory visits in the fields of youth, boy scouts and girl guides to learn about the experiments of the two countries.
2. Republic of Yemen shall send a 10-member youth delegation to Pakistan during the currency period of the exchange

program for period of 7-days and Pakistan side shall send a 10-member youth delegation to Republic of Yemen for the same duration during the said period. The time and dates of the visits will be decided through mutual negotiations.

3. The sending side shall bear the expenses for international travel (round trip) of the delegation(s) and the receiving side shall bear the cost of local hospitality, including boarding, lodging, emergency medical care and local transportation related to the visiting delegation.

General Provisions

- ✓ a- Each side shall bear the cost of the travel and travel allowances of the delegation from its country to the other's country.
- ✓ b- The boarding/lodging, local transport and medical care shall be borne by the hosting country.
- ✓ c- This Protocol remains in force for (4) years as of the date of signing it and is renewable for the similar period, unless otherwise terminated through mutual understanding of the Parties.

This Protocol is done and signed at Islamabad on 10 April 2006, corresponding to 11 Rabi-ul-Awwal 1427 H in the Arabic and English languages, both being equally authentic.
