SUBJECT: PUBLIC DISCLAIMER - PAKISTAN MIXED MARTIAL ARTS FEDERATION

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that the Constitution of Pakistan Sports Board (PSB) 2022 was duly approved by the Federal Government (Cabinet) in exercise of the powers conferred under Sections 3 and 4 of the Sports (Development and Control) Ordinance, 1962. Under Rule 2(ix) and Rule 7(1)(xxxiii) of the PSB Constitution, only those federations affiliated with PSB may be considered "National Sports Federations (NSFs)," use the name "Pakistan," and send teams abroad. Non-recognized entities are not entitled to use the name "Pakistan" or claim the status of an NSF.

2. It has come to the notice of PSB that one Mr. Babar Qayoom Raja is organizing the "Mixed Martial Arts National Championship NFT 4 Season 4" at SA Gardens, Phase 2, Lahore, and is unlawfully using the logo of Pakistan Sports Board.

3. It is clarified that the Pakistan Mixed Martial Arts Federation is not affiliated with the Pakistan Sports Board. This entity is falsely using the official PSB logo and misrepresenting itself as a national federation for the sport of Mixed Martial Arts, despite having no affiliation with or recognition from PSB.

4. Accordingly, any communication, activity, promotion, or decision issued by Mr. Babar Qayoom Raja or his organization in connection with Mixed Martial Arts using the PSB logo holds no legal validity and must be disregarded by all concerned stakeholders, including federations, institutions, departments, and athletes.

5. Mr. Babar Qayoom Raja is hereby directed to immediately cease the unauthorized use of the Pakistan Sports Board logo and stop styling his organization as the "Pakistan Mixed Martial Arts Federation."
