SUBJECT: PUBLIC DISCLAIMER - PARAGLIDING AND HANG GLIDING FEDERATION

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that the Constitution of Pakistan Sports Board (PSB), 2022 was duly approved by the Federal Government (Cabinet) under Sections 3 and 4 of the Sports (Development and Control) Ordinance, 1962. In terms of Rule 2(ix) and Rule 7(1)(xxxiii) of the PSB Constitution, only those federations which are duly affiliated with the Pakistan Sports Board are entitled to be recognized as National Sports Federations, use the name "Pakistan," represent the country internationally, or project themselves as government-recognized entities.

2. In this regard, it is clarified for public information that the Pakistan Sports Board, in its 34th Meeting held on 23 July 2025, disaffiliated the Paragliding and Hang Gliding Federation due to its failure to fulfil the mandatory affiliation criteria prescribed under the Constitution of Pakistan Sports Board, 2022.

3. Despite its disaffiliation, it has come to the notice of the Pakistan Sports Board that the said so-called Federation is still unlawfully:

- Using the name "Pakistan";
- Using the official logo of the Pakistan Sports Board; and
- Collecting money from the public for issuance of pilot licenses while portraying itself as a government-recognized or PSB-affiliated body.

4. It is hereby clarified that the Paragliding and Hang Gliding Federation has no affiliation, recognition, or linkage whatsoever with the Pakistan Sports Board. Any licenses, certificates, permissions, activities, or financial transactions carried out by the said entity are entirely at its own risk and responsibility.

5. The general public, athletes, pilots, institutions, departments and all concerned stakeholders are advised to remain cautious and informed that the Pakistan Sports Board shall not be responsible for any fraud, financial loss, misrepresentation, untoward incident, or legal consequence arising out of dealings with the said entity.

6. The disaffiliated entity is directed to immediately cease the unauthorized use of the name "Pakistan," the logo of Pakistan Sports Board, and any claim of government or PSB recognition.

7. This disclaimer is issued in the public interest.
